	Attempt, conspiracy or incitement to commit the above offences

A prohibited person includes a Registrable person under the Child Protection (Offenders Registration) Act 2000. Details of these offences can be found online at Working with Children Employer Guidelines Fact Sheet<sup>1</sup>. A conviction includes a finding that the charge for an offence is proven, or that a person is guilty of an offence, even though the court does not proceed to conviction.
